Narrative: Summary Description of Purpose

Advance Juvenile Justice reform efforts in Orleans Parish Juvenile Justice System:

- Create an annually produced public-facing document/report that represents the data story/narrative of the status of the Juvenile Justice System in Orleans Parish. Use this process to establish a data-informed baseline + target areas for change.
- Initiate community-wide conversations focused on informing and improving individual, system and community outcomes for system-involved youth. Refer to public-facing document as a basis for information sharing and engagement in change/improvement processes.

- City of New Orleans approved the PAY Ordinance which allows Police Officers to issue warning citations instead of arresting youth for school offenses.
