- Contact with dedicated youth advocate 3-5 times per week
- Individualized goal-setting
- Assistance with basic needs

YEP Educates

- High school equivalency instruction and test preparation for ages 16 and up
- Drop in adult education classes
- College and financial aid application assistance
- Support for basic needs, transportation, and testing fees



YEP Enriches

- Arts, music, and recreational after-school program for youth, ages 7-18
- Six-week summer camp for youth, ages 7-12
- Weekend overnight camp for youth, ages 9-12, impacted by the substance use of a family member
