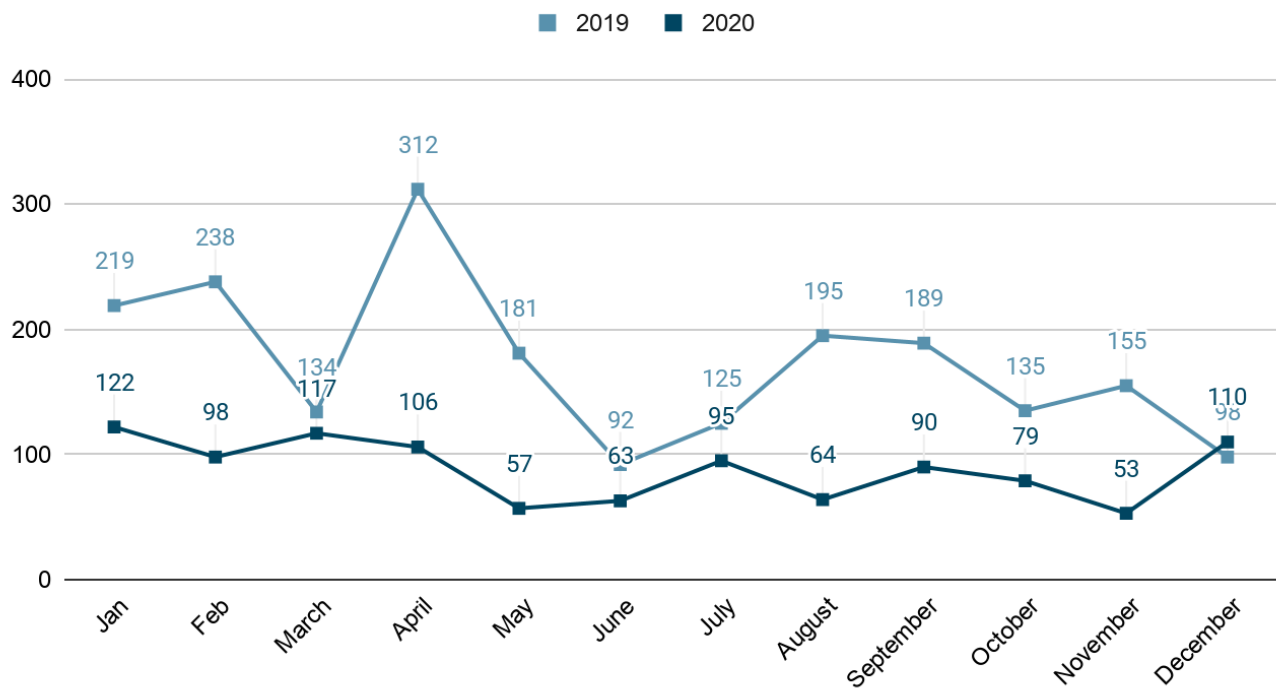
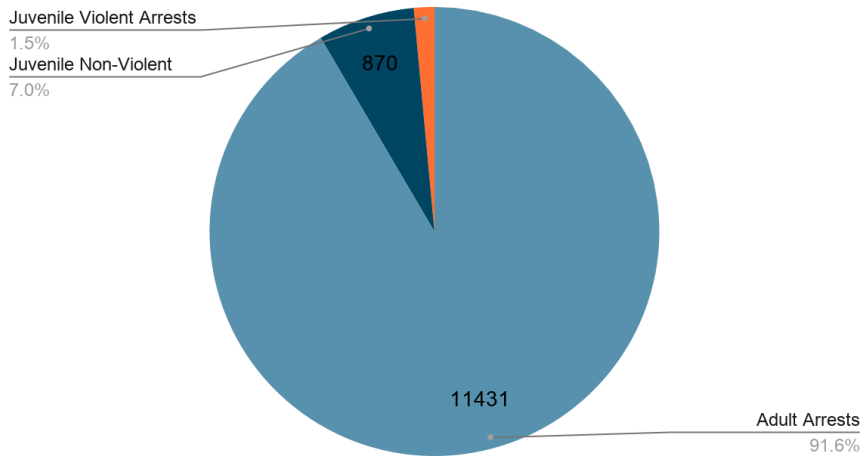


2019 vs. 2020 Juvenile Arrests

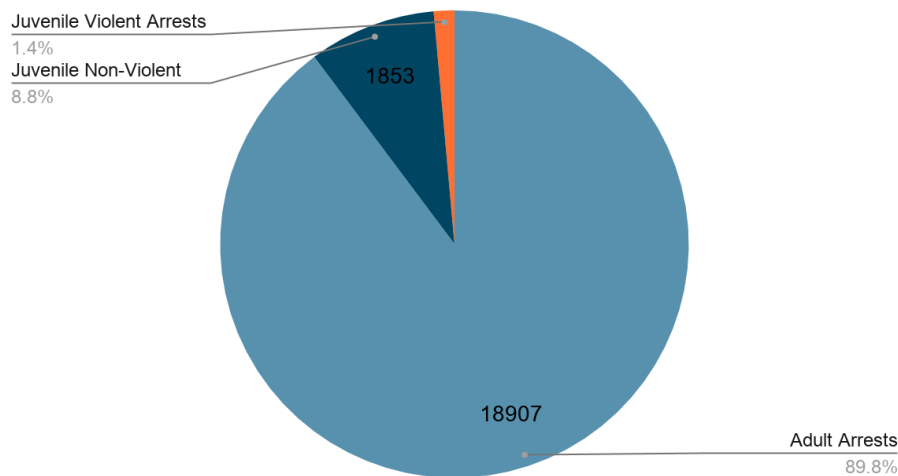


- Overall, juvenile arrests in 2020 are below 2019 levels
- Nonetheless, there was an uptick in juvenile arrests at the end of 2020 (from 53 in November to 110 in December)

2019 Juvenile vs. Adult Arrests



- In 2020, 8-10% of citywide arrests in New Orleans were juvenile arrests. The vast majority of those arrests are for non-violent offenses.
 - In 2019 and 2020, about 1.5% of all citywide arrests are juvenile arrests for a violent offense
 - In 2019, 8.8% of overall arrests were for non-violent offenses by juveniles and in 2020, 7% were for non-violent offenses by juveniles
- The vast majority of children in New Orleans have never interacted with the juvenile justice system - Less than 2% of the ~45,000 children ages 10-19 are arrested every year.
 - 2019 - 796 unique juveniles (2019 total juvenile arrests- 2,073)
 - 2020 - 515 unique juveniles (2020 total juvenile arrests- 1,054)
